



Introduction

The Pueblo of Laguna predates the Pueblo Revolt, and is one of a series of ancestral pueblos occupied since time immemorial. Currently, the Pueblo of Laguna is one of the largest Keresan speaking Pueblos in New Mexico, with over eight thousand enrolled members. The Pueblo of Laguna has six major villages, Laguna, Paguete, Encinal, Mesita, Seama, and Paraje/Casa Blanca.

The coming of Spaniards and Franciscan friars played a dramatic role on the lives of the Laguna people. They utilized Laguna laborers, and instilled their European cultural values into the Laguna people. The Laguna people incorporated many of these values into their own traditional culture; today Laguna celebrates feast days of various Catholic Saints with both Laguna

and Christian prayer. Many still practice their native traditions, and have the freedom to worship in accordance with their respective religious beliefs and practices, as long as it does not interfere with the traditional ways of the Pueblo.

Written history speaks of the brutality inflicted upon the Pueblo people that resisted Spanish rule. Through those painful experiences of the past 400 years, the Laguna language and culture has survived. The Laguna people adapted to colonial rule by adopting and incorporating those aspects of the dominant culture necessary for survival while maintaining the basic fabric of traditional culture. Reconciliation continues to take place as we celebrate the feast days of various saints with both Native and Christian prayer.

Per the Pueblo of Laguna Constitution members of the Pueblo shall have the freedom to worship in accordance with their respective religious beliefs and practices, as long as the religion shall not interfere with the traditional religious practices of the Pueblo.

Despite the fact that Laguna Pueblo faced much hardship they remained resilient and adaptable; because of those traits they praise and encourage youth towards higher education. To ensure academic success there is a scholarship program offered by the Pueblo that enables many to accomplish their goals. The younger generations serve as portals for the bettering of the community and practices of the traditional beliefs.

Economics

Prior to the 1950s, agricultural practices were the mainstay of Laguna's economy. The decline in agricultural practices commenced with the discovery of uranium and the subsequent decision to mine it in the early 1950s. The mining operation created a revenue stream for the Pueblo as well as job opportunities for many Laguna members. The decline in the price of uranium ore resulted in the end of mining operations in 1982.

In light of the health issues we currently are facing, Laguna has declared a moratorium on any future uranium mining. This is in spite of the fact that there currently is a demand for uranium and there are still significant uranium deposits on the reservation.

Another opportunity the Pueblo had for employment was the Atlantic & Pacific Rail Road. In 1880 Atlantic & Pacific entered New Mexico and began laying track on the Laguna Reservation. Laguna took the arrival of the railroads construction crew as an opportunity to set a precedent. Laguna agreed to allow the railroad to pass through the reservation only if the railroad agreed to employ Laguna members.

In addition, many talented artists have emerged from Pueblo of Laguna. After being re-established in the 1970's the work of the geometric designs of pottery making has slowly gained a modern touch including innovative designs. Their personal touch sets them apart from other Native craftsmen.

Today many Pueblo members are employed by the Pueblo government as well as by the corporations and entities that have been established since the closure of the uranium mine. Pueblo members are also employed by other governmental agencies within the private sector. Others have established businesses on and off the reservation.

The Future

Today Laguna thrives through a vibrant blend of modern and traditional ways. The Pueblo of Laguna Council has established five priorities to enhance the quality of life for its membership. They are: Healthcare, Education, Financial Stability, Infrastructure, and Work Force Excellence. Of greater importance, however, is to ensure the survival of our culture, traditions and language. As they have sustained us throughout the centuries, we must ensure they sustain future generations as well.


Figure 2 Pottery by Evelyn Cheromiah (Laguna), Photo Credit: King Galleries (kinggalleries.com), Source: Google Images


Resources by Users




