PUEBLO OF LAGUNA SECRETARIAL ELECTION
OCTOBER 19, 2012**

Pursuant to a Secretarial Election authorized by the Southwest Regional Director on August 31, 2012, the attached Constitution Amendments of the Pueblo of Laguna, was submitted to the qualified voters of the tribe and on October 19, 2012:


AMENDMENT A was duly Adopted, by a vote of 575 FOR and 106 AGAINST for a total of 681. Nine (9) spoiled Amendment A Ballots.

AMENDMENT B was duly Adopted, by a vote of 567 FOR and 117 AGAINST for a total of 684. Six (6) spoiled Amendment B Ballots.

AMENDMENT C was duly Adopted, by a vote of 576 FOR and 111 AGAINST for a total of 687. Three (3) spoiled Amendment C Ballots.

13 SPOILED OR MUTILATED cast ballots.




