CERTIFICATE OF RESULTS OF ELECTION PUEBLO OF LAGUNA SECRETARIAL ELECTION OCTOBER 19, 2012

Pursuant to a Secretarial Election authorized by the Southwest Regional Director on August 31, 2012, the attached Constitution Amendments of the Pueblo of Laguna, was submitted to the qualified voters of the tribe and on October 19, 2012:

AMENDMENT A was duly Adopted, by a vote of <u>575</u> FOR and <u>106</u> AGAINST for a total of 681. Nine (9) spoiled Amendment A Ballots.

<u>AMENDMENT B</u> was duly Adopted, by a vote of <u>567</u> FOR and <u>117</u> AGAINST for a total of 684. Six (6) spoiled Amendment B Ballots.

<u>AMENDMENT C</u> was duly Adopted, by a vote of <u>576</u> FOR and <u>111</u> AGAINST for a total of 687. Three (3) spoiled Amendment C Ballots.

TO AMEND <u>ARTICLE II, SECTION 1-MEMBERSHIP</u>
OF THE LAGUNA CONSTITUTION-WHICH REMOVES THE
TWO YEAR (2) YEAR ENROLLMENT REQUIREMENT TO
SUBMIT ENROLLMENT APPLICATIONS TO ENROLL
CHILDREN INTO THE TRIBE.
