

DSM-V CRITERIA FOR GAMBLING DISORDER

- A. PERSISTENT AND RECURRENT PROBLEMATIC GAMBLING BEHAVIOR LEADING TO CLINICALLY SIGNIFICANT IMPAIRMMENT OR DISTRESS, AS INDICATED BY THE INDIVIDUAL EXHIBITING FOUR (OR MORE) OF THE FOLLOWING IN A 12-MONTH PERIOD:
- I. Tolerance-Needs to gamble with increasing amounts of money in order to achieve the desired excitement.
- Withdrawal-Is restless or irritable when attempting to cut down or stop gambling
- Preoccupation-Has persistent thoughts of reliving past gambling experiences, handicapping or planning next venture, thinking of ways to get money with which to gamble.
- Escape-Gambles when feeling distress (e.g., helpless, quilty, anxious, depressed)
- 5. Chasing-After losing money gambling, often returns another day to get even ("chasing" one's losses).
- Lying-Lies to family, friends, and others to conceal the extent of the involvement with gambling.
- Risks Relationships/Opportunities-Has jeopardized or lost a significant relationship, job, or educational career opportunity because of gambling.
- 8. Bailout-Relies on others to provide money to relieve desperate linancial situations caused by gambling
- 9. Loss of Control-Fails in an effort to control or stop gambling.
