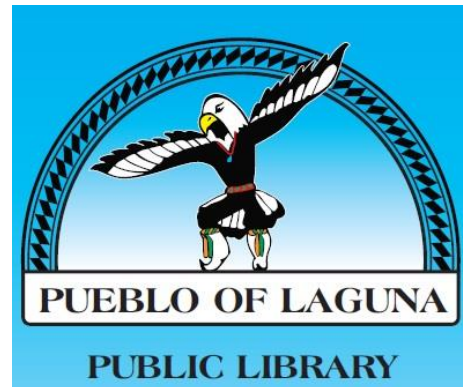

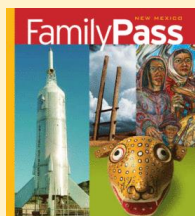
Q: How do you use the Inter-Library Loan program?
