# NOTICE

Pursuant to Pueblo of Laguna Rules of Criminal Procedure, Rule 18 allows for release on bail by posting bond. The court also can retain such bail/bond while the criminal prosecution is pending to ensure the defendant complies with release conditions and required appearances.

## **Rule 18. Pre-Trial Commitment and Release**

### **Section A. Generally.**

All defendants arrested and incarcerated shall be subject to a temporary commitment order after charges have been filed pending arraignment, investigation, or trial but may post bail and be released or be released on the defendant's own recognizance as provided herein.

### **Section D. Factors and evidence.**

In determining whether to release a defendant or the amount of bail or the conditions of release, the court may consider the nature and circumstance of the offense charged, the weight of the evidence, the defendant's prior record, history, and characteristics, any pending warrants or cases, the safety and well being of the general public, and any other facts indicating whether the defendant will appear as required.

### **G. Release.**

A posted bail shall be released to the person(s) who posted it when the bail conditions have been performed, upon proof of identity via government-issued photo identification.

### **Bond Acknowledgment (Statement on Bond Receipt)**
